LĪHUʻE — The County of Kauaʻi, in partnership with Child & Family Service and local community organizations, invites the public to the “Recovery Through Connections and Community” fair on Friday, Sept. 12, from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the Historic County Building Lawn.
